

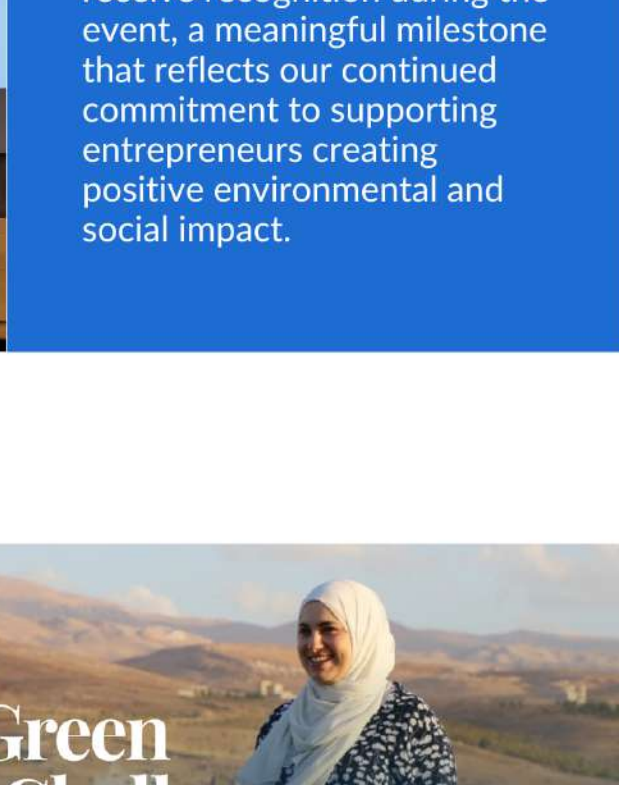

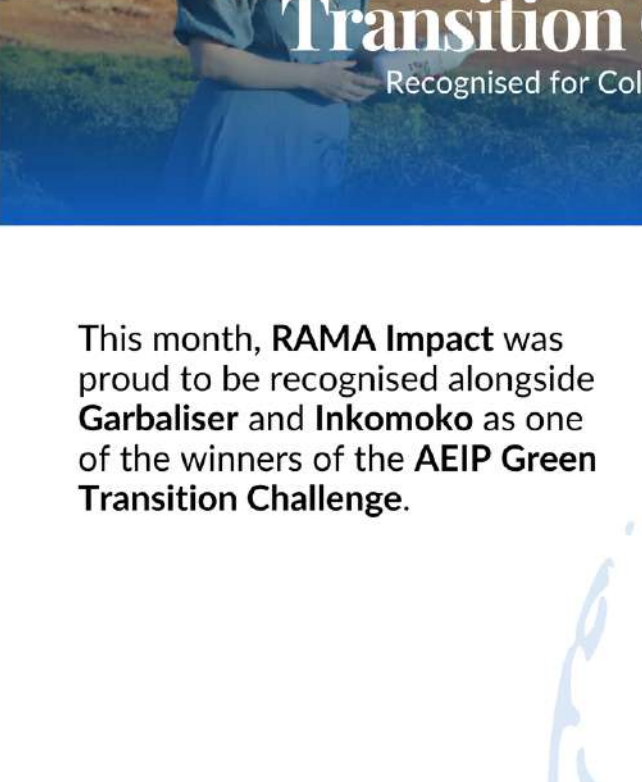

AEIP Green Transition Challenge

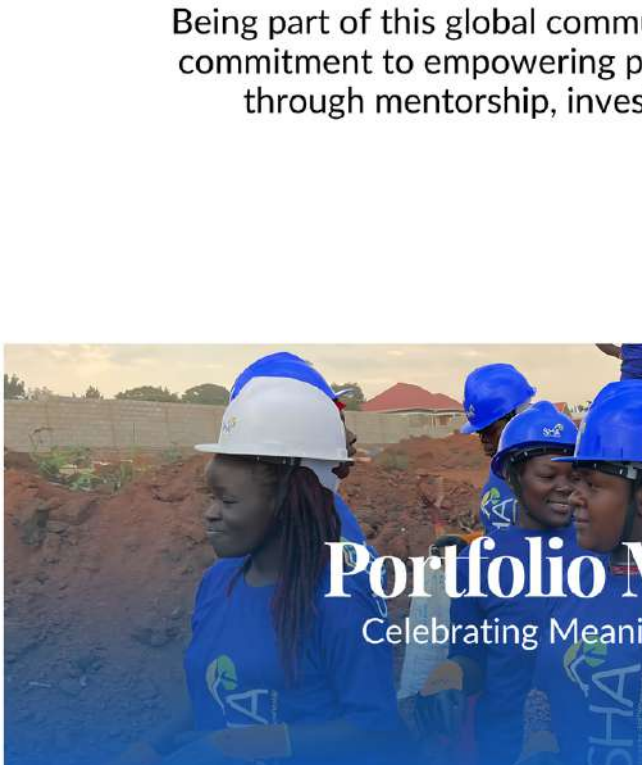
Recognised for Collaborative Impact

This recognition highlights the importance of locally led, climate-focused solutions across **Africa** and the **MENA** region.



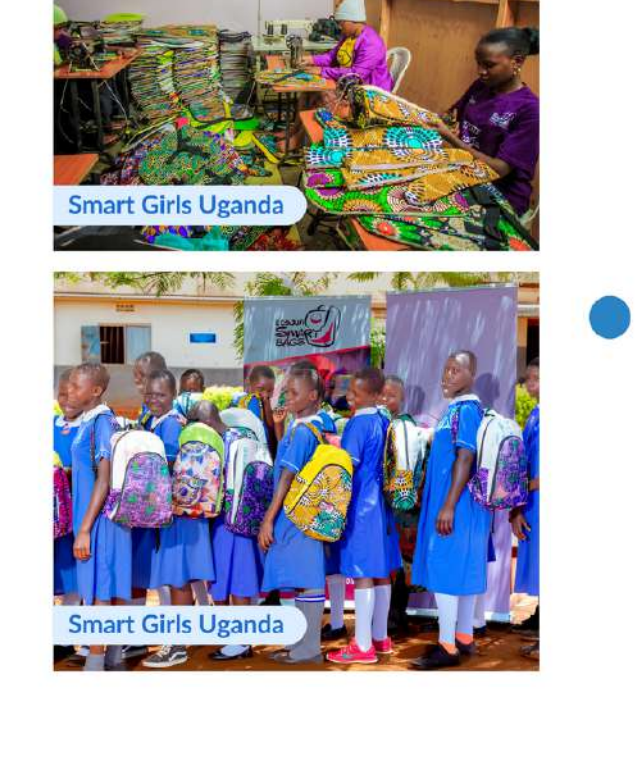
The partnership was recognised for its innovation, sustainability potential and commitment to advancing the green transition while creating opportunities for women and youth across underserved communities.

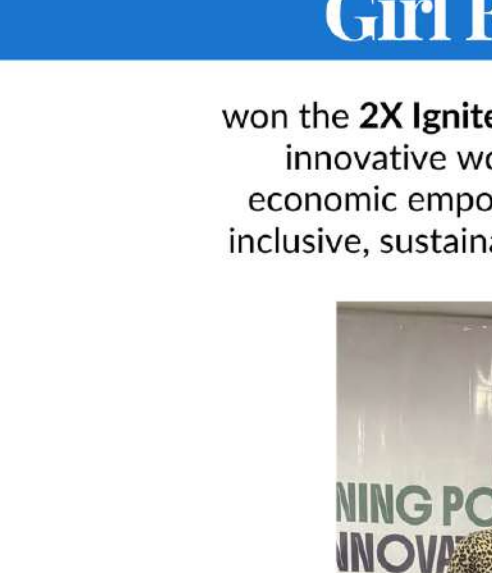
The **Cartier Women's Initiative** is one of the world's leading programmes supporting women impact entrepreneurs tackling today's most pressing global challenges.

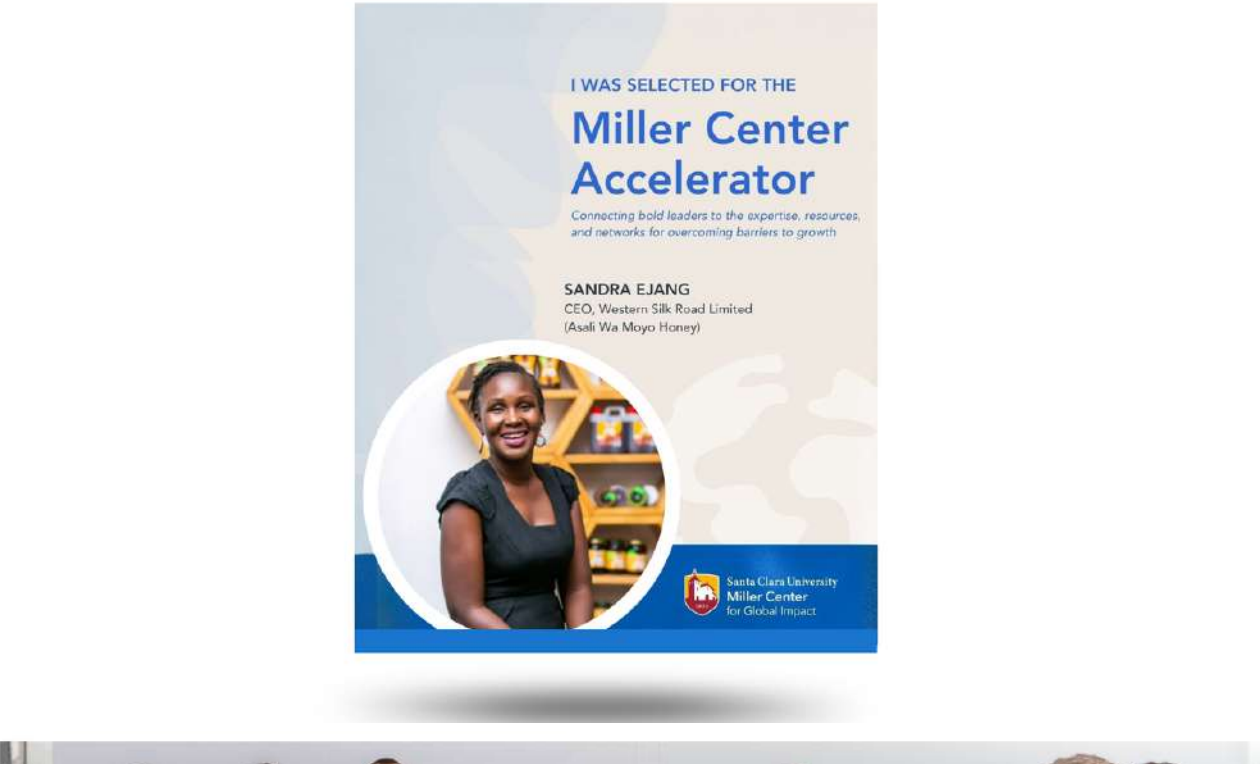
Successful Loan Repayments

Every repayment recycles opportunity. As loans are repaid, capital is reinvested into new women-led social enterprises, creating a ripple effect of lasting social and environmental impact.

● **SHAfrica** and **Smart Girls Uganda** have successfully repaid their first RAMA Impact loans, marking an important milestone in their growth journeys and becoming eligible to apply for follow-on financing as they continue to scale.

● Since joining the RAMA Impact portfolio, **SHAfrica** has increased land and home ownership among low-income women by **53%**, trained **270** women in homeownership and financial literacy, and achieved **IFC EDGE Certification** for sustainable construction.

● With RAMA Impact's financial and non-financial support, **Smart Girls Uganda** increased revenue by **114%**, distributed **2,145** Ecojua Smart Bags to girls in off-grid and underserved areas, created **8** jobs for women, and repurposed **645** kilograms of plastic waste.

MIRRIAH Joins the RAMA Impact Portfolio

We are delighted to welcome **MIRRIAH**, the woman-owned climate-tech social enterprise co-founded by **Nidal Tafah** in Morocco, to the **RAMA Impact** pre-loan portfolio.



With RAMA Impact's support, **MIRRIAH** aims to grow revenue by **20%**, create **3** jobs, onboard up to **50** farming families, and reduce water use and **CO₂** emissions over the next **12** months.

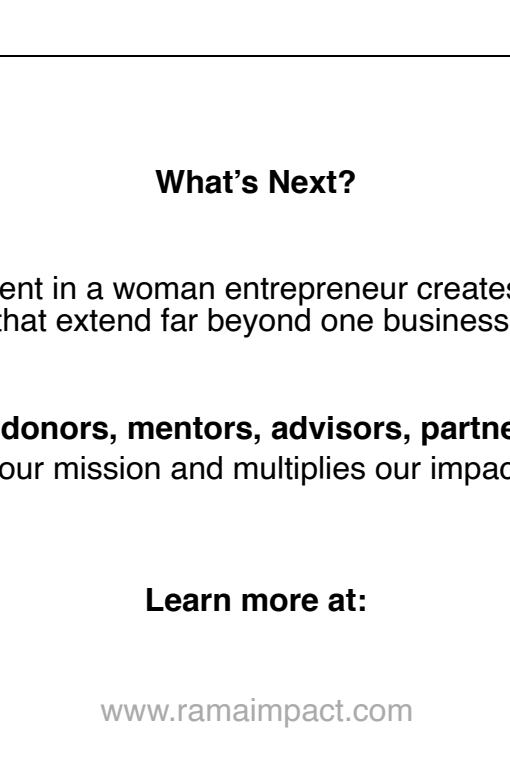
